Annotation	The rapid development of the pharmaceutical industry and the emergence of numerous drugs such as topical corticosteroids play a significant role in the increase in the number of cases of dermatoses without a typical clinical picture. The objective: to review the features of clinical and laboratory diagnosis of dermatitis, particularly of infectious origin, and to present a recent case of smooth skin mycosis. Materials and methods: the object of study was the diagnosis and therapy of rubrophytia complicated by bacterial infection.
